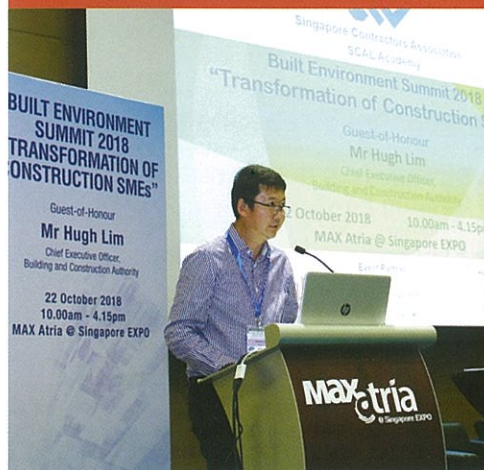
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CONTRACTORS CONTRIBUTE EXPERTISE AND SKILLS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

In support of the MMT initiative, major works this year included the Relocation of Massage Centre and Office, including additions and alterations. This was to cater to the recent increased demand in walk-in customers and to also provide a greater source of income for the masseurs.

Other revamp works included improving the drainage and ramp works, replacement of urinals and installation of directional tactile.

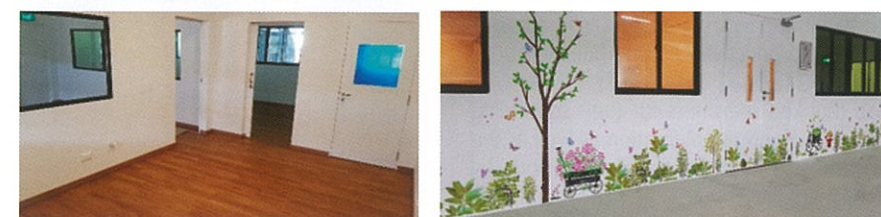
